The humble Petition of William Davis

Sheweth

That his daughter Ann Davis was convicted at the Sessions at [Flick's] Hall in April last and sentence to 7 years transportation for a robbery which she committed on the person of Captain Wilson (of the Brig Resource) while with him on a brothel near King James stairs in the Parish of Saint Paul, Shadwell.

Your Petitioner prays that she may be allowed to finish her term of imprisonment in this country at the same time pronouncing that when such term is finished that she will be received at home and all exertion will be made to reform her past conduct and cause her to become a respectable member of the community.
