Omagh July 18 1849

Sir – at the assize for the County of Tyrone concluded this day Anne Forbes now a prisoner in Omagh gaol as found guilty before me of the murder of her newly borne infant child – I had sentence of death recorded against her pursuant to the Statute – and I now beg to recommend to his Excellency the Lord Lieutenant that the Prisoners sentence be commuted to transportation for ten years.
