Sir

I have the Honor to Report to you for the information of his Excellency the Lord Lieutenant that at the late Assizes for Co. Fermanagh Biddy McMahon was convicted before me of the murder of her infant child – From the circumstances endorsed in the Sentence, I thought it a Proper case to record Sentence of Death – which I respectfully submit should be commuted to transportation for Life.
